## **Next Step Triple Threat**

John 13:34-35; 15:12-17; Romans 12:9-13

- 1. Last week we talked about taking a guy to coffee to get to know him. If anyone did so this week, have him share his story. Who did you invite? Why? What did you talk about? Was it easier or harder than you thought?
- 2. Why is it hard to engage a man in an "intentional spiritual friendship"? Are some guys easier than others to do this with?
- 3. If the Great Commandment was to love God with everything you've got, and to love your neighbor, why did Jesus give the disciples the New Commandment, to love one another? What are some tangible ways that Jesus and the disciples loved others?
- 4. The *Next Step Triple Threat* gives you three ways to continue investing in a man's life. Which option makes sense for a man you are getting to know?
