- 3. Would you agree that we each have more in common with the Pharisees than we might first think? What is one Pharisaic tendency you have that you would like to bring under the corrective grace of the Holy Spirit? How can the other men help you (e.g., ask how doing, meet privately if someone has special wisdom or experience)?
