1. What does it mean to “be saved?” Read Ephesians 2:8,9 out loud. According to this passage, what is the cause of our salvation? What is NOT the cause?
2. “A lot of Christians know they need God’s grace for salvation but think their sanctification is up to them.” As you look at the Christians you know, does that statement seem true? How do men try to “sanctify” themselves?
3. What are some specific areas that you would like to grow in your faith? It may be having stronger faith, or living out one or more of the fruits of the Spirit. As you pray, confess your “holy incompetence” to achieve Christ-likeness in your own strength, and ask God to help you grow in this area through the power of the Holy Spirit.
