- 2. Read Genesis 2:18. What two reasons are given for having a wife? What are some other reasons that having a wife is a good thing?
- 3. Read Ephesians 5:25. Who is the church? How did Christ love the church? How did Christ give himself up for the church?
- 4. The Bible's ethos for marriage is one man and one woman, mutually submitted, mutually obligated, with the husband as the head. This "headship" is to be understood more as a position of obligation than privilege, though both. C. S. Lewis, commenting on Ephesians 5:25, said, "This headship is most fully embodied...in him whose marriage is most like a crucifixion." If married, what would be one practical way you could "give yourself up" for ______?
