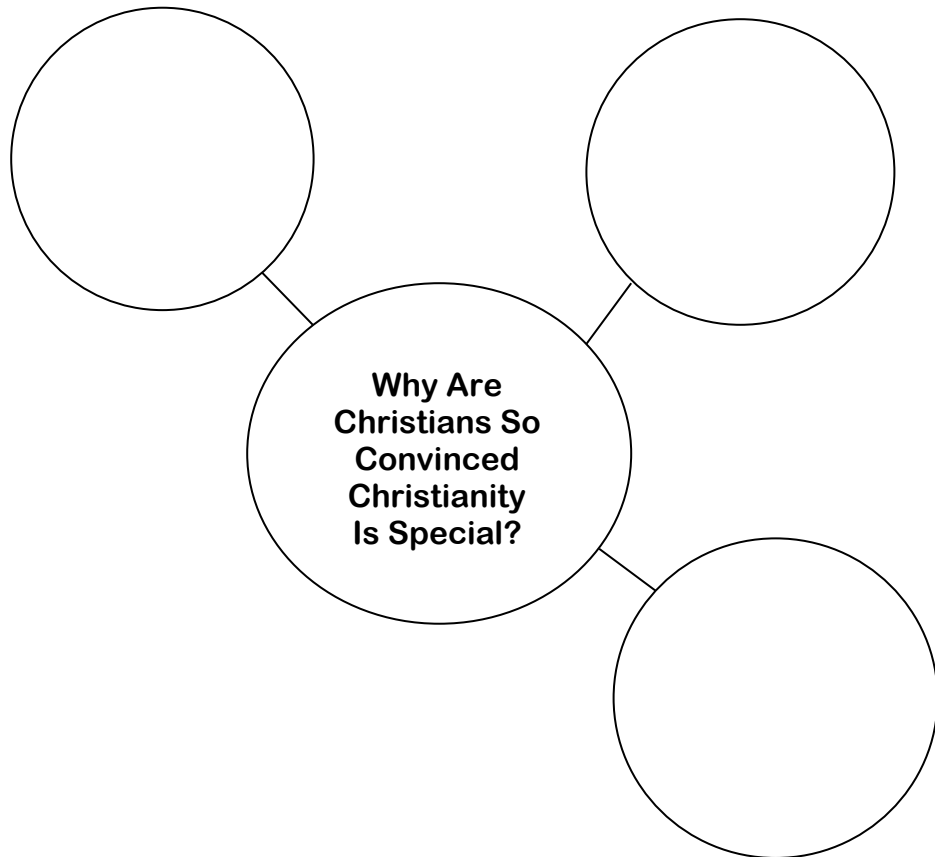


TABLE TALK:

1. What was it about the story of Jesus that sealed the deal for you? What do you think would most likely seal the deal for the seekers you know?
2. Paul lays out his, and our, ministries in 2 Corinthians 2:14-5:21. For example, we are the aroma of Christ, a letter from Christ, ministers of a new covenant, treasures in jars of clay, outwardly wasting away but renewed day by day, confronted by troubles characterized as light and momentary, given the Spirit as a deposit guaranteeing what is to come, compelled by Christ's love, persuading men, no longer regarding anyone from a worldly point of view, reconciled to God, given the ministry of reconciliation, ambassadors of Christ with God making his appeal through us. Which of these ideas, or any other ideas in the text, did you most want and need to hear about this morning? How does this passage line up with what you already believe about outreach? What's fresh? Can you picture doing something differently and, if so, what?
3. Who are the men you would like to add (or confirm) to your Reach 3 card? Pray for Jesus to give you an unreasonable burden to tell the story to one of these men. Rough draft your 3 Minute Elevator Testimony and be prepared to share it with the other men in your group next week.
