


TABLE TALK:

1. Is there a dire situation that you, or someone you care about, are in right now? How has that been messing with how you feel about God, your faith, and your future?

2. In Exodus 14, the situation could not have been any worse. The odds were stacked against Moses. But in spite of being completely out of options, how did Moses respond to the impending disaster in verses 13-14? Does it sound like Moses knew what was coming next, according to verse 15? What happened next?

3. The Big Idea today is, "Like Moses, I want to trust God so much that I don't feel like I have to make something happen." Moses had many experiences that brought him to such a faith. Which of those experiences have you had too, and how have they helped you trust God more?
