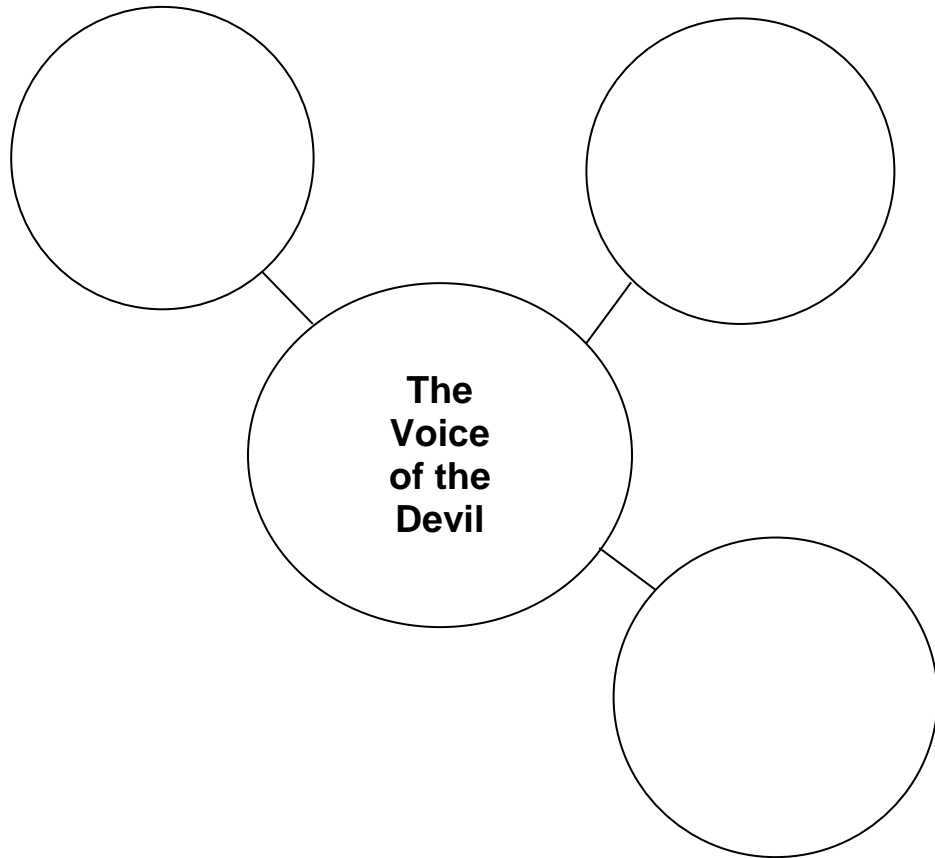


TABLE TALK:

1. What is the devil's preferred point of entry to get in your head? For example, it could be about God, what is truth, your wife, your work, your identity, how you find your worth, your children or grandchildren, friendships, your forgiveness, financial or eternal security, sinful behaviors, spiritual disciplines, the relevance of Christianity today, church hurts, or something else.

2. To which of the devil's "tools" (lies, accusations, temptations) are you most vulnerable, and why? For example, anxiety, anger, doubt, fear, worry, distrust, self-loathing, deceit, greed, pride, jealousy, envy, worldly desires/behaviors, sinful desires/behaviors, shame, depression, or rejection.

3. Name the seven "tools" God has given us to resist the devil in Ephesians 6:14-18. Which ones do you feel skilled at using? Which ones need more training? What have you learned or been reminded of in this lesson that can increase your competence to recognize and reject the voice of the devil?
