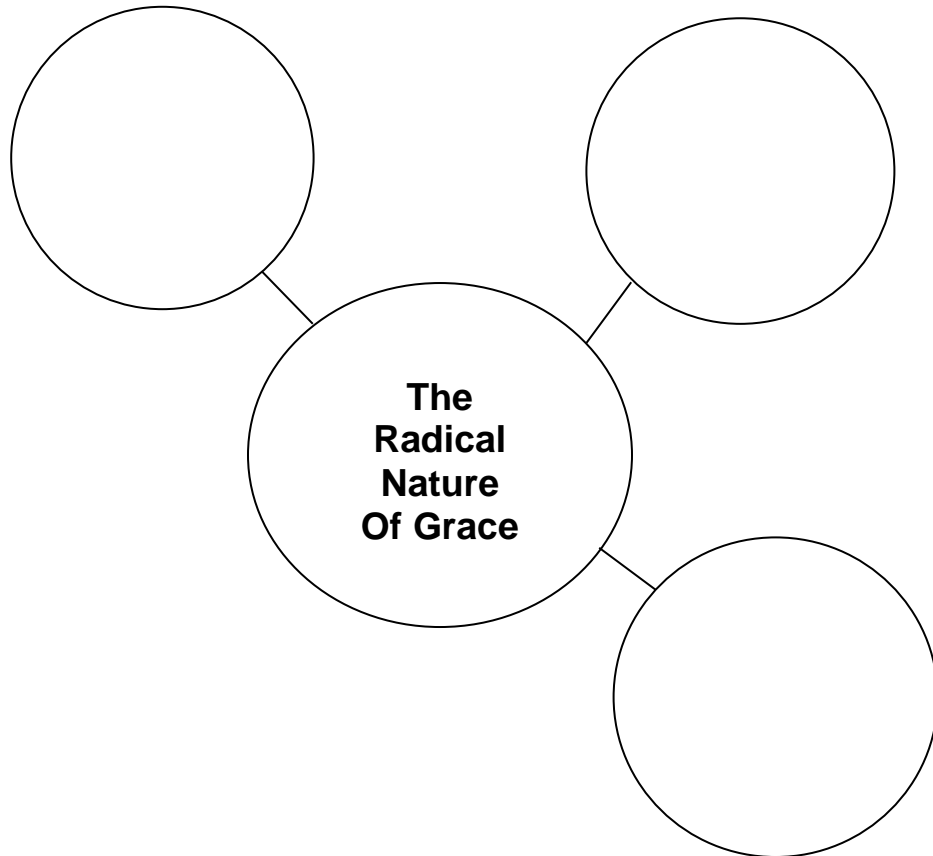
### The Radical Nature of Grace
