- Who is the villain in this story according to verse 14, 21, and 23?
- Can you see that sin is part of the normal Christian experience? (see verses 21-23)

3. The Big Idea is, "You are not the villain. Sin is the villain. And Jesus Christ can be your hero." How can this way of understanding sin help you? How can it help in your ministry to men and the people you care about?
