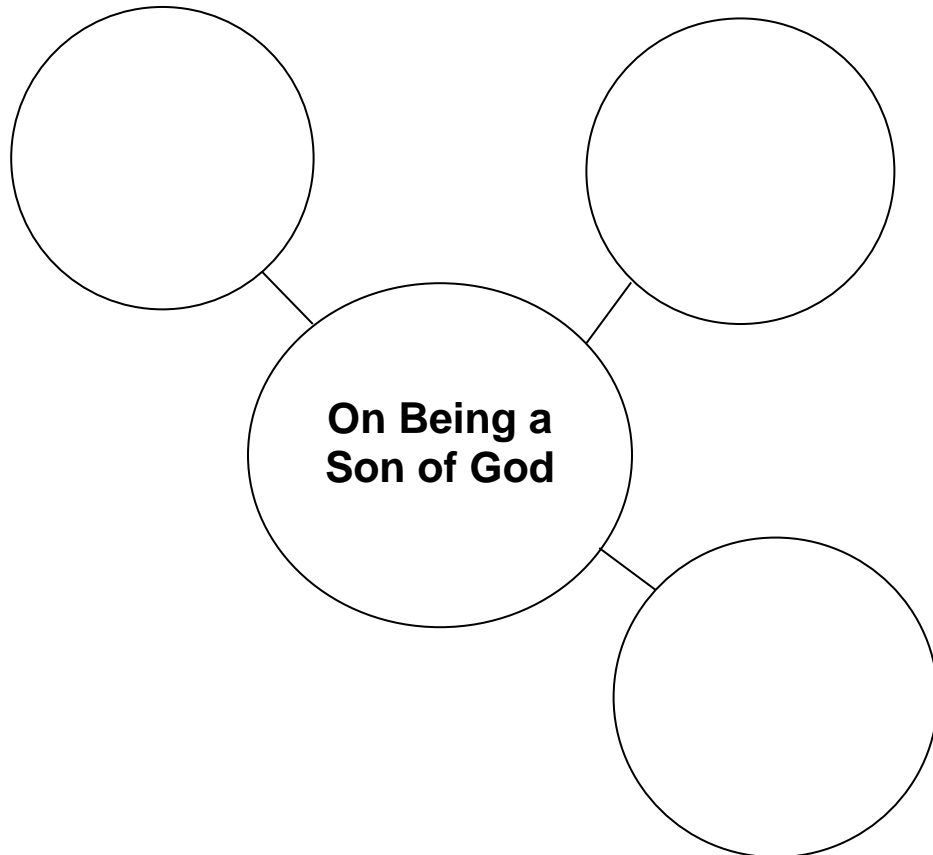


TABLE TALK:

3. Paul says in verses 14-17 that we are sons (and daughters) of God, but the last phrase in verse 17 lists a condition and a reward. What is it and what does it mean?
4. Review the passages about the unmerciful servant and the ten lepers. (Matt 18:21-35, Luke 17:11-19) Who do you identify more with in each parable? Why?
