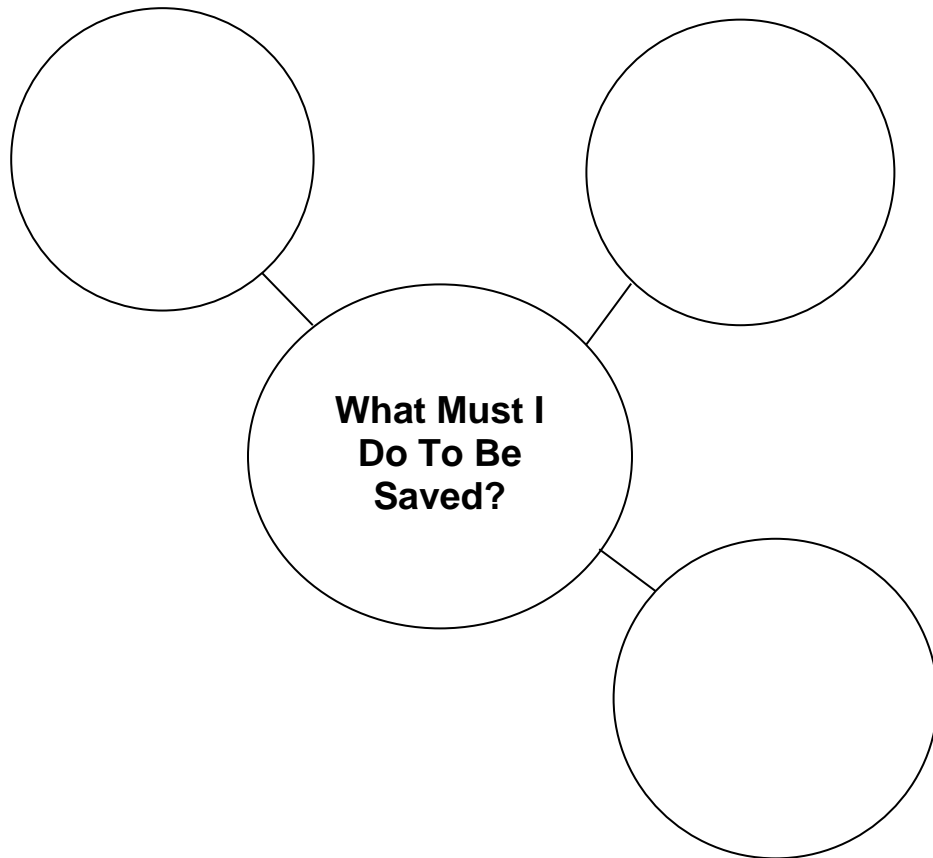


TABLE TALK:
