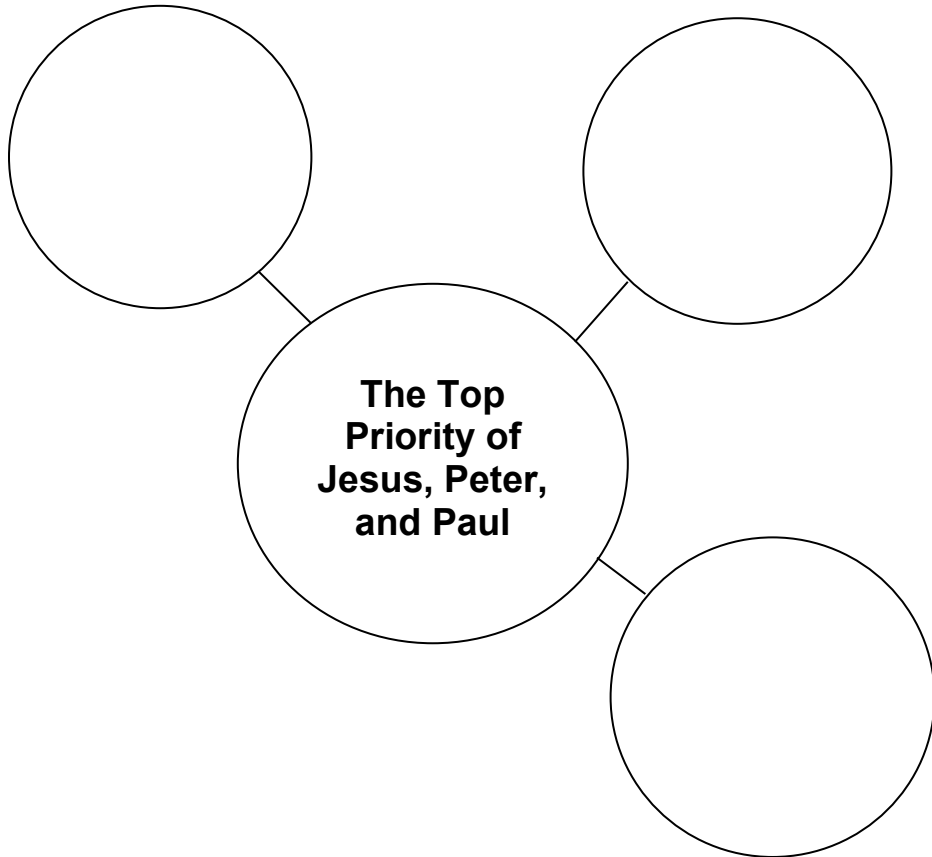


TABLE TALK:

2. What is the top priority of Jesus, Peter, and Paul as described in today's text and John 13:34-35, Galatians 5:13-14, and 1 Peter 5:8? What are the implications for your top priority?
3. Pick a familiar situation in which you could easily respond with indifference, anger, disappointment, self-righteousness, or other negative emotion. For example, you may not suffer fools easily, or you find it hard to be forgiving when someone doesn't meet your expectations. It might happen at home or work. What have you learned or been reminded of today about love that can help you the next time that specific situation comes up?
