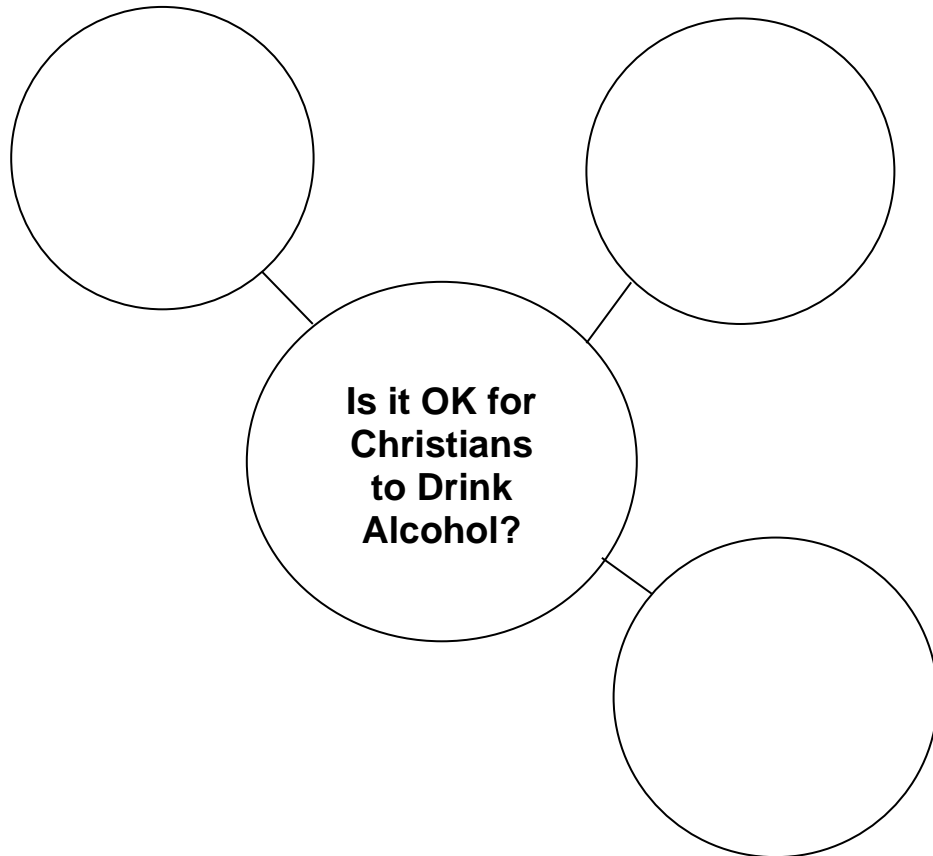
### Is it OK for Christians to Drink Alcohol?
