


TABLE TALK:

1. To what kind of service has God called you? Maybe it's your vision, or maybe you've embraced the vision He gave your church or an organization. If you haven't been called yet, what has He been saying to you—today in particular?

2. In today's passage, Paul announced his plans to see the Romans after a trip to Jerusalem where, according to Acts 20:23-24 and 21:11-14, he expected nothing but trouble. From today's text, what was Paul's view and approach to struggles? (For more verses on his experience, view and approach to struggles see 2 Corinthians 11:23-29, 1 Thessalonians 2:1-2, 1 Corinthians 16:8-9, 2 Corinthians 12:7-9, Acts 14:22, and 2 Timothy 3:12).

3. Are you all in like Paul, and why or why not? What have you picked up on today that can make you more of a never quit kind of guy? For example:

- Settle your calling, let the gospel get under your skin
- Make a plan, little will happen merely because it should
- Serve someone in need, here or elsewhere
- Teach others by example and words
- Ask people to pray for your struggles, pray for them
