What is it?

The **No Man Left Behind Essentials** is a training event for leaders and ministry teams who are committed to reaching men in the context of the local church. The content of the course is delivered in teaching sessions over 1 ½ days. Interspersed between sessions are **learning activities**, small group **discussions**, application exercises, and some time for **planning** and group **feedback**.

Churches that have implemented the No Man Left Behind Model report that in an average of just two and a half years, they had **48% more men attending church**, and **84% more men involved in discipleship activities**.

Who should come?

Men's **leaders**, laymen and, if possible, the senior **pastor** should attend this **team training together**. Leaders may also want to invite key men in their church who they would like to see become further involved in ministry leadership and who share a **passion** to see men discipled.
