	-13	Finalize date and times for <i>The Marriage Prayer Challenge:</i>

	-13	Send in completed event contract to Man in the Mirror. (25 copies of <i>The Marriage Prayer</i> included.)		
	-12	Download Faith & Life Objectives (F&LO) card and pre-challenge Assessment form from website and modify as needed with team.

	-4	Order <i>When Good Men Are Tempted</i> for the men's-only groups. If you need more copies of <i>The Marriage Prayer</i> book beyond the 25 provided, contact Man in the Mirror.		
	-4	Order Saving Your Marriage Before It Starts books and workbooks for pre-marital groups. (Note: There is a men's workbook and a women's workbook.)

		Capture Momentum		
	0	Connect couples into follow-up groups BEFORE they leave <i>The Marriage Prayer Challenge</i> .		
	0	The men's-only follow-up groups meet for the first time, using <i>When Good Men Are Tempted</i> . Group leaders should distribute F&LO cards and collect Assessments as needed.		
	0	Invite ALL men to join the men's-only follow-up groups.		
	1	The pre-marital groups meet for the first time, using <i>Saving Your Marriage Before It Starts</i> . Group leaders should distribute F&LO cards and collect Assessments as needed.		
	1	The couples' groups meet for the first time, using <i>The Marriage Prayer</i> . Group leaders should distribute F&LO cards and collect Assessments as needed.		
	1	Invite ALL the married couples in the church to join the couples' follow-up groups.		
	3	Plug men who aren't directly participating into other small groups and ongoing ministries. Use the All-Inclusive suggestions.		
	3	Re-communicate the F&LOs and discuss in groups.		
	4	Have group participants agree to continue the Sustain study the following week, using the same book they're going through for Capture. Allow men/couples to shift groups as needed.		
		Sustain Change		
	5	Continue follow-up groups, using same resources.		
	5-11	Help people outside the groups stay engaged in the challenge, using All-Inclusive ideas.		
	6-10	Give people an opportunity to put what they're learning into action, using a "Hands" suggestion from the checklist. Advertise church-wide to ALL the men/couples in the church.		
	8	Download post-challenge Assessment form. Modify as needed and have the pastor approve. Print one for every man in the church.		
	9	Choose date/time for the celebration dessert night: Invite pastor and leaders.		
	10	Reserve room/location for celebration evening:		
	11	Have the group leaders distribute the post-challenge Assessment in the final week of the study. Men should complete it based on how they're living their lives <i>recently</i> . Collect.		
		Evaluate & Celebrate		
	11	Distribute and collect post-challenge Assessment for all the men in the church during weekend services, classes, and other groups. Aim to keep these separate from the Assessments of the men who participated directly in the groups.		
	12	Make sure all Assessments have been collected. Create a report; keep the results of the participants in the groups separate if possible. Share the report with your pastor and team.		
	12	Ask those who led groups for the names of men/couples who particularly benefitted from Challenge 3.		
	12	Meet with team. Finalize drinks and desserts, as well as agenda, for celebration. Secure childcare.		
	12	Announce the celebration night and invite ALL the adults in the church.		
	13	Ask the men and couples recommended by the group leaders to share their stories with you or another team member—either by email, video, or at the celebration. Ask for permission to share.		
	14	Celebrate! Announce the results of the Assessment, remind them of their F&LOs, pray together, share testimonies, and enjoy!		
	14	Announce Challenge 4 to men at the celebration! Ask them to consider, "Who's missing?" and invite others on The Journey from outside the church.
