- I will have developed the habits of a learner and will continue to grow in my knowledge and love for God. (Hands)



FAITH & LIFE OBJECTIVES BUILD GODLY RELATIONSHIPS AND MARRIAGES

The Christian man is built for relationship. At the end of this leg of the journey:

- I will understand that relationships give me the chance to love others as Christ loves me. If married, I will understand that my marriage is a gift from God that represents Christ's love for the church. (Head)
